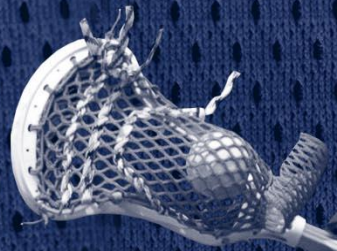

Formal Mentor Program

- Established by LOA or Individuals
- Mutual Trust and Confidence
- Multiple Seasons

RAISE YOUR GAME



Responsibilities of Mentored Official

- Listen
- Select official that you want to be like or emulate
- Establish and Communicate Goals
 - Each Game; Each Season; 3 Years; 5 Years
- Review Game Film

RAISE YOUR GAME



Responsibilities of Mentored Official

- Attend Games Your Mentor Works
 - Observe; Ask questions
 - Get different angles
 - From the box; GLE; Stands
- Ask Mentor to Watch and Evaluate You
 - Ask for and Expect more than just constructive criticism
- Call mentor each wee or after each significant game or Issue

Responsibilities or Mentor

- Listen
- Challenge the Apprentice
- Be Hard but Fair
- Review Goals and Hold Them Accountable
- Do Not Tattle

RAISE YOUR GAME



Responsibilities of Mentor

- Practice What You Preach
- Be available to work with Apprentice
- When Deserved – search for opportunities for apprentice to work a higher level or bigger game – preferably with you.
- Go out & Evaluate Apprentice
